

Tenure Track Assistant or Associate Professor Position (Theatre and Dance)

The Department of Theatre & Dance at the University of South Alabama invites applications for a full-time (9 month) tenure-track assistant or associate professor in Theatre, with a primary concentration in Scenery and Lighting, starting August 15, 2021. An MFA in Scenic or Lighting Design is preferred, but an MFA or PhD in other theater areas will be considered if it couples with extensive experience in Scenery and Lighting, including both design and construction.

In addition to the above consideration, the Department is looking for someone who can teach courses in Introduction to Theatre, Theatre History, and/or Dramatic Literature. Opportunities also exist to design and or direct in the program's production season.

To apply, attach (1) a cover letter that briefly addresses the applicant's suitability for teaching courses in the desired areas of concentration; (2) evidence of design and construction capabilities; (3) CV; (4) brief statement of teaching philosophy; (5) evidence of teaching effectiveness; (6) contact information (email, phone, and mailing address) for three professional references; and, (7) transcripts (copies are acceptable initially but candidates invited to interview will have to request that all official transcripts be sent from colleges/universities attended to the Chair of the Search Committee).
