

Senior Instructor in Information Systems and Technology

The School of Computing at the University of South Alabama is soliciting applications for a full-time senior instructor with a start date of January 1, 2026. A master's degree or higher in information systems, information technology, or a closely related area is required. Applicants must have a minimum of seven years of teaching experience in higher education. Qualified candidates must be committed to student success and retention. Primary duties include teaching undergraduate courses in computer information systems, information technology, programming, project management, data communications, and other courses as assigned.
