Applicants should possess an earned doctoral degree in Psychology, but ABD's near completion of the degree will be considered. Applicants should also possess a strong commitment to teaching. The teaching load is four courses per semester, covering a variety of topics, with an emphasis in experimental courses. All specialty areas are encouraged to apply. Preference will be given to candidates with experience and/or expertise in Introductory Psychology, Development, and Behavior Analysis.

Review of applications will begin June 10, 2024, and will continue until the position is filled.
